**Company: ImmunoSig Ltd.** (company number 16642090), a company incorporated in England and Wales, with its registered office at 86-90 Paul Street, London, EC2A 4NE ("Company," "we," "our," or "us").

We value your privacy and are committed to protecting personal data in compliance with applicable laws, including the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

### 1. What this policy covers

## 2. Data we collect through this website

We may collect:

- Contact details you provide when completing a form or emailing us (e.g. name, email, organisation).
- Technical information such as your IP address, browser type, operating system, and referring URLs.
- Cookie and analytics data if you consent, we use Google Analytics 4 to understand how visitors use our site. These analytics are anonymous, and IP addresses are anonymised.

We do not collect sensitive personal data through this website.

#### 3. How we use this data

We use your information to:

- Respond to enquiries and provide requested information. By making an enquiry, you are consenting to us using your personal data to respond to your query.
- Monitor and improve our website's security and performance. We do this
  because it is in our legitimate interests to keep our website secure and optimise
  its performance.
- Analyse usage (only if you consent to analytics cookies).

• Comply with any legally binding request, such as from a competent authority, on the basis that we have a legal obligation to do so.

## 4. Cookies and analytics

Our website uses essential cookies to operate, and optional cookies (Google Analytics) with your consent.

You can manage or withdraw consent at any time using the "Manage Cookies" icon or your browser settings.

## 5. Sharing and storage

We only share limited information with trusted service providers (e.g., web hosting, analytics).

All third parties follow strict confidentiality and security measures.

#### Where we store and transfer data

We use reputable service providers for hosting, DNS, and analytics. As a result, your information may be processed in the UK, the EEA, the United States, or other countries where these providers operate.

When personal data is transferred outside the UK/EEA, we rely on appropriate safeguards, such as:

- the UK's adequacy regulations (including the UK-US Data Bridge where applicable), and/or
- the UK Addendum to the EU Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs).

We also apply technical and organisational measures (such as encryption and access controls) to protect your data.

#### Our key service providers

- Carrd, Inc. hosts and delivers the ImmunoSig website content.
- Namecheap, Inc. manages our domain and Cloudflare, Inc. our DNS (no tracking or analytics data).
- Google LLC (Google Analytics 4) provides optional, consent-based anonymous analytics.

Analytics only operates if you accept cookies via the banner.

#### 6. Data retention

- Enquiry emails: kept for up to 12 months after our last correspondence, unless further communication is required.
- Cookie preferences: stored in your browser for 1 year (cookie\_consent\_v2).
- Analytics data:
  - o Google Analytics cookies expire after approximately 13 months.
  - Event and user data within Google Analytics are retained for up to 14 months, as configured in our analytics settings.
- You can withdraw or change your consent for analytics at any time by selecting "Manage Cookies" or choosing "Disable analytics" on our website.

## 7. Your Rights (UK GDPR)

Under UK GDPR, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- 1. **Right of Access:** Request a copy of your personal data.
- 2. **Right to Rectification:** Correct inaccurate or incomplete data.
- 3. **Right to Erasure:** Request deletion of your personal data, subject to legal or contractual obligations.
- 4. **Right to Restrict Processing:** Limit processing under certain circumstances.
- 5. **Right to Data Portability:** Receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used format.
- 6. **Right to Object:** Object to processing for direct marketing or legitimate interests.
- 7. **Right to Withdraw Consent:** Where processing is based on consent, you can withdraw it at any time.
